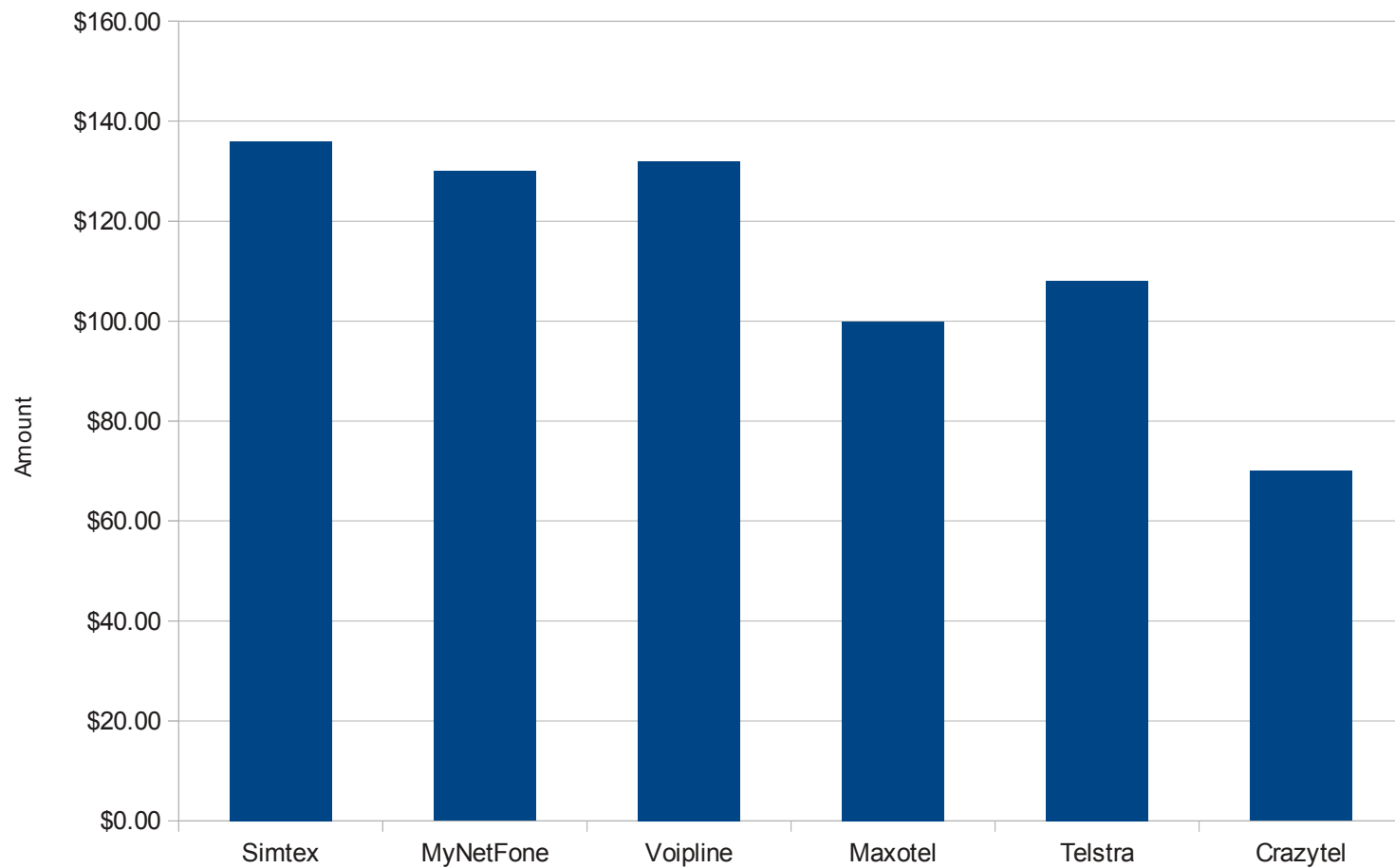

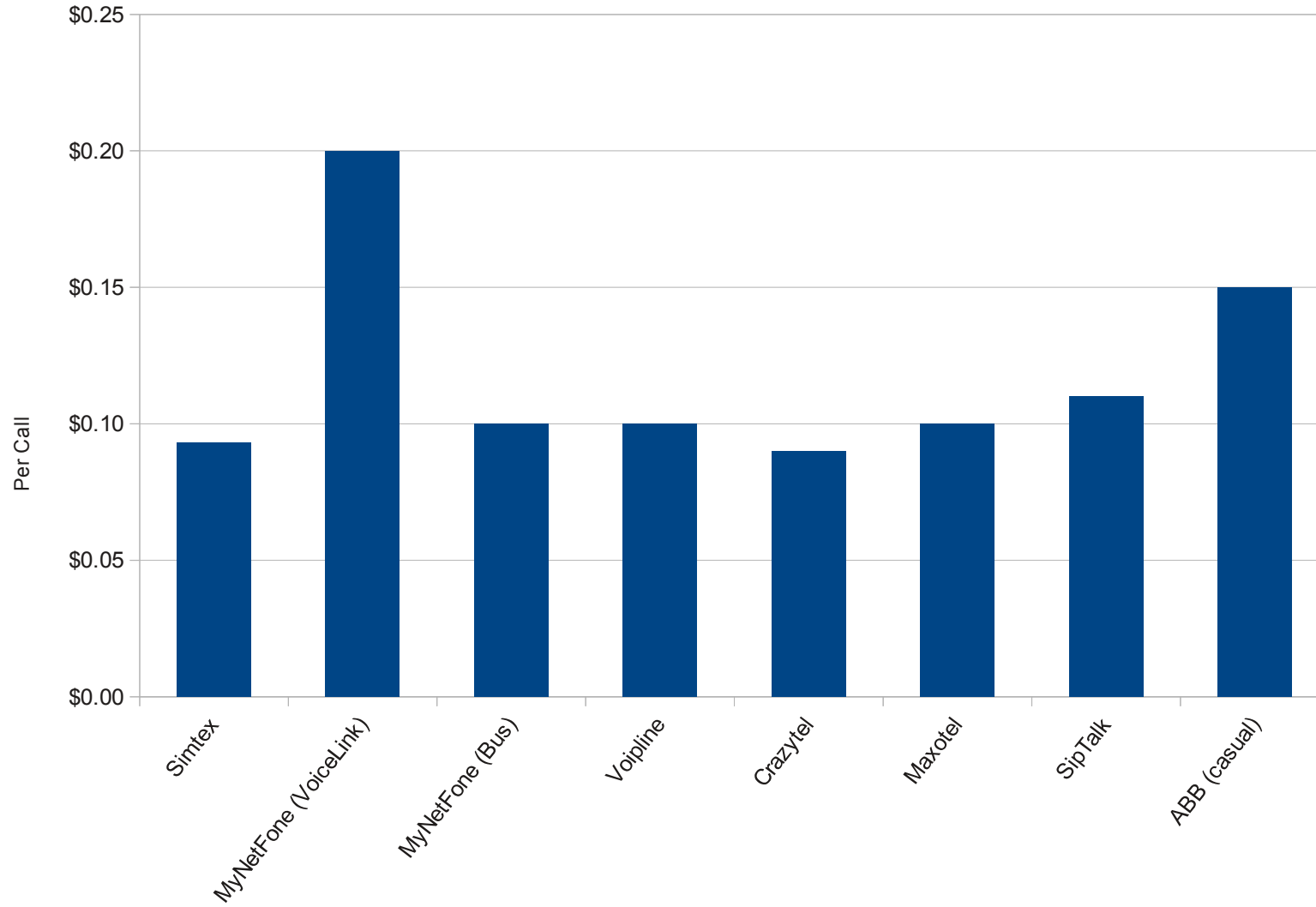

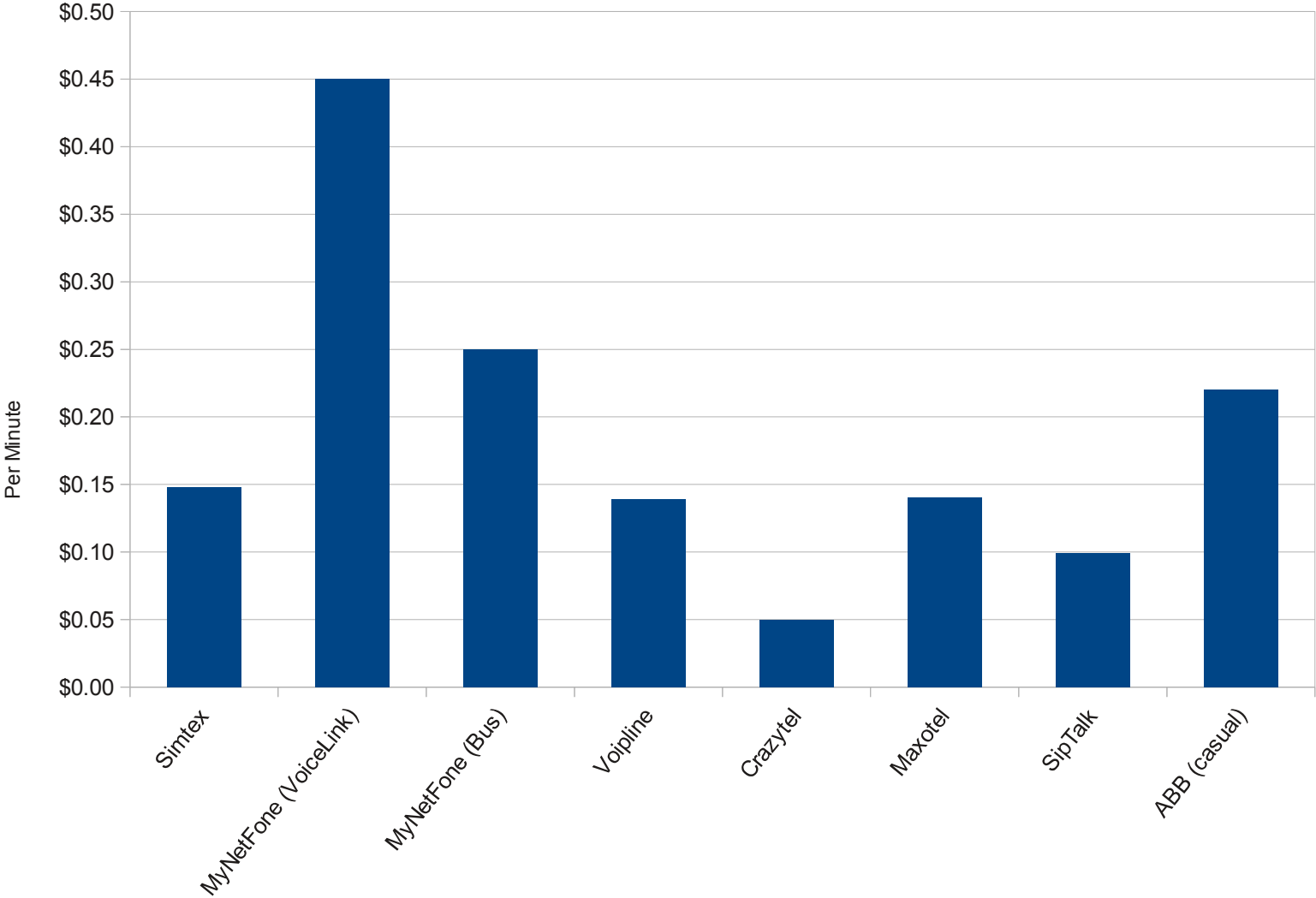

Why this?

I deal with Telecoms & Data, with more and more businesses forced onto NBN, SIP is the new POTS, the new ISDN, the new way of voice communications, so I needed a quick *goto* guide to help make suggestions and show whats around without them spending hours researching, sort of like shortlisting for them.

Why don't we include x, y ,z?

We know there are many other SIP services out there, some well known, some not so, if they do not meet the below section *How can I get a plan added*, we intentionally omit them, mostly because they don't list complete pricing

How can I get a plan added?

Trunk plans for business must be upfront and clear about inclusions and exclusions, T&C's that can be read without engaging a lawyer, and published pricing Email noelb@ausics.net with information on the VSP, including a URL linking to their plans and all pricing (Inc. International), and any links to show they have credibility, eg: people are happy with them (links to Social Media or forums), or links showing well known brands using them as voice provider.

° If the VSP only lists single channel costs per unlimited channel, we will double it to make 2 lines, since most businesses want at least two lines.

Crazytel Warning

Crazytel DID charges are double dipped, the way they work is if you buy first DID(s) on for example the 5th of the month, that's your anniversary billing date, nothing wrong there, but if you buy more DIDs on the 29th of the month, you are billed *full price* for those DIDs, again, nothing wrong there, but on the 5th, you will be billed *again* for your original DIDs *and* the *new DIDs you bought a few days ago*, you are charged full rate both times.
